PREAMBLE :

The National Testing Agency (NTA) is an autonomous organization under the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education, Government of India. It is a self-sustained testing organization to conduct entrance examinations for admission/fellowship in higher educational institutions and it conducts such tests for ICAR. As per the National Education Policy 2020, one nation one entrance test is being emphasized, therefore it is important to adopt NTA conducted entrance test for ICAR throughout the country and many farm universities have adopted the same.

After detailed deliberation in the "All Farm Universities Coordination subcommittee" meeting held on 07.05.2022 at UHS, Bagalkot, it was decided to adopt the system of PG admission to Master's and Doctoral degrees by considering the aggregate of 50 percent marks obtained in the NTA-ICAR examination plus 50 percent marks obtained in the B.Sc./M.Sc. degree programme respectively from the academic year 2022-23 and onwards. Hence, the order.

ORDER:

In view of the above, the University of Horticultural Sciences, Bagalkot has adopted the new system for admission to Master's and Doctoral degree programmes by considering the aggregate of 50 percent marks obtained in the NTA-ICAR examination plus 50 percent marks obtained in the qualifying degree. The ranking of the student is decided by the total score derived after adding the Scores of NTA-ICAR with 50 percent weightage and marks of qualifying examinations with 50 percent weightage.

If aggregate or total marks [NTA-ICAR 50% weightage and qualifying exam 50% weightage] of more than one candidate are equal, then these tie[s] is/are resolved in accordance with the following criteria.

- a) The candidate securing more marks in the NTA-ICAR examination is to be put in the higher rank.
- b) In a case where the marks mentioned above are also equal, then the candidate senior in age is to be put in the higher rank.

This shall come into effect from the academic year 2022-23 and onwards.
